NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the power conferred by rule 4 of the West Bengal Ethanol Blended Petrol Rules, 2008 notified vide no. 41-EX dated January 11, 2008, I, the Excise Commissioner, West Bengal, do hereby prescribe with immediate effect the following form of license for possession, storage and issue of denatured spirit/special denatured spirit for blending with petrol:—

**“LICENSE FOR POSSESSION, STORAGE AND ISSUE OF DENATURED SPIRIT/SPECIAL
DENATURED SPIRIT FOR BLENDING WITH PETROL**

It is required of the holder of this license hereinafter called the licensee as a condition of its remaining in force that he/they duly and faithfully perform and abide by the following conditions and by all the provisions of the West Bengal Ethanol Blended Petrol Rules, 2008 and the Bengal Excise Act, 1909 as amended (hereinafter referred to as the "Act") and the rules and orders made there under so far as they are applicable to such warehouse:—

1. The licensee shall be bound by the provisions of the Bengal Excise Act, 1909, as amended up to date, the West Bengal Ethanol Blended Petrol Rules, 2008 and other regulations and orders made there under.
2. The license extends to the possession, storage and issue of denatured spirit/special denatured spirit for the purpose of blending the same with petrol.
3. The denatured spirit/special denatured spirit shall be kept in the licensed premises and shall neither be sold nor transferred nor used for purposes other than those specified in the license.
4. The license shall be deemed to have been granted to the licensee and it shall not be transferred or leased or sub-let or sold without the previous permission of the Excise Commissioner.
5. The licensee shall not change the premises in which he carries on his business under his license except with the previous permission of the Excise Commissioner which fact should be noted on the license by the Collector or any officer duly empowered by him and the Excise Commissioner informed.
6. If the licensee goes out of business, he shall dispose of his stock of denatured spirit/special denatured spirit in such a manner as the Excise Commissioner may direct.
7. The licensee shall not sell or part with as gift or otherwise any quantity of denatured spirit/special denatured spirit obtained under the license or utilize it for purposes other than stated in the license.
8. Every quantity of denatured spirit/special denatured spirit required to be removed from the storage tanks for the purpose of blending with petrol within the same licensed premises must be recorded with detailed particulars by the licensee prior to such removal in a prescribed register and every such removal shall be verified and countersigned by the excise officer-in-charge of the licensed premises.
9. No denatured spirit/special denatured spirit shall be removed from one licensed premise for transport to another licensed premise of the same Oil Marketing Company without a transport pass in prescribed form issued by the excise officer-in-charge of the licensed premises with the prior approval of the Collector.
10. Any attempt on the part of the licensee to reature denatured spirit/special denatured spirit or render denatured spirit/special denatured spirit fit for human consumption shall make him liable to cancellation of his license in addition to the penalties that may be imposed under the Bengal Excise Act, 1909 as amended. If the spirit is insufficiently denatured, the inspecting officer may seize the spirit in question.
11. Every vat, tank or other receptacle containing denatured spirit/special denatured spirit received into and kept for storage in the licensed premises shall be legibly painted, branded or labelled with words "Denatured Spirit/Special Denatured Spirit" in red and shall have affixed to it the image of a human skull and cross bones with a warning in English and Bengali. In cases of storage of spirit in underground tanks, suitable sign boards shall be provided by the licensee indicating the location and capacity of such underground tanks. The design and style of the label and the sign boards shall be approved by the Excise Commissioner.
12. All vats, receptacles or underground tanks used for the storage of spirit should be suitably calibrated and certified as such to the satisfaction of the Collector, should bear distinctive serial numbers and their full capacities should be distinctly and intelligibly marked over them.
13. The room where denatured spirit/special denatured spirit is stored shall be built of unflamable material and shall be well ventilated so as to prevent the accumulation of spirit fumes. No naked lights or fire shall be used or kept in such room. All receptacles containing such spirit shall be kept closed so as to prevent the accumulation of spirit fumes in the room. The entire licensed premises used for storing denatured spirit/special denatured spirit should be covered by a valid fire license issued by competent authority.
14. The licensee shall maintain all requisite registers prescribed for the business carried on by him and on the expiry of his license shall make them over to the Superintendent of Excise of the district where the licensed premises are located under a valid receipt. The licensee shall submit all prescribed returns punctually and maintain daily account of transactions of denatured spirit/special denatured spirit in prescribed registers.
15. The licensee shall at any time produce for inspection on demand his license and accounts by an excise officer not below the rank of a Sub-Inspector and shall allow the inspection of his licensed premises, his license, registers, permits or passes and the total stock of denatured spirit/special denatured spirit by the said officer.
16. The spirit used shall contain denaturants approved by the Excise Commissioner and the denaturants shall be in the proportion as may be prescribed by the Excise Commissioner.
